## BENEFITS OF READING COMPREHENSION

Higher levels of comprehension increase the effectiveness and enjoyment in what students will read. Comprehension is the act of understanding the content a student reads in their daily life, in or out of school. Whether from a book, homework, or test instructions, it is imperative that students are able to recognize and interpret ideas from reading.

## WHAT WE LEARN
